PROCESS

The Asteria US Core Equity Strategy invests primarily in US stocks diversified across various market sectors. All positions are monitored and analyzed on at least a bi-weekly basis, and annual turnover is targeted at less than 50 percent. Holding periods are generally at least one year, however holdings made be added or sold at any time.

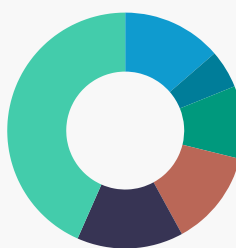

DEFINITIONS **Standard deviation:** a measure of the dispersion of a set of data from its mean. It is designed to gauge the historical risk of an investment in terms of its past volatility. **Sharpe Ratio:** the average return earned in excess of the risk-free rate per unit of volatility or total risk. **Russell 3000 Index:** a market-capitalization-weighted equity index maintained by FTSE Russell that provides exposure to the entire U.S. stock market. The index tracks the performance of the 3,000 largest U.S.-traded stocks which represent about 98% of all U.S. incorporated equity securities.

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
